Hello Post Members,

Until we actually see the kids splashing each other

All repairs were originally scheduled to be completed between May 12<sup>th</sup> and May 16th. The pool must be filled immediately after the job is finished and that should take about 24 hours. Then there is a 7-day waiting period before anyone is allowed in the water. If we can stick to that schedule, it leaves us a 3- or 4-day cushion before opening day. The big question is will we be able to stay on schedule with the additional repairs? We should have most of the answers by our General Membership Meeting on May 3<sup>rd</sup>.
