Example of when the Expense Reports are required, Toys \$ Tots, Memorial/4th of July/Labor Day picnics, fund raising dances, game nights, Beer & Beers, Pig

Roast, Pancake Breakfast, Christmas Dinners or Parties and so on. If unsure, please ask.

Please note, Retail (nonmember) or Member Rentals of the Hall for private use are NOT included in this requirement.
